Preamble

- E. To promote the implementation of United Nations instruments and global goals on environmental issues, sustainable development, climate change, and responsible consumption and production;

a member or employees of Free Tree Society shall agree to abide by the Society's Code of Ethics.

Code of Ethics

Members and employees of Free Tree Society shall endeavour to:

1. Uphold the dignity and integrity of Free Tree Society by being honest, respectful and responsible;
2. Respect and comply with all applicable environmental legislations, regulations, rules and by-laws;
3. Act, and encourage others to practise, in an environmentally responsible and sustainable manner, by reducing consumption of resources through waste minimisation including a practice of reduce, reuse and recycle;
4. Be constantly aware of the environmental impacts of his or her daily activities and aim to minimise those impacts;
5. Promote a love of nature in particular towards planting and propagating greenery in urban spaces;
6. Take appropriate measures to avoid damage to the environment and ensure equitable use of available natural resources, taking into account the needs of a diverse society;
7. Not engage in illegal activities nor in conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit, misrepresentation or deception;
8. Refrain from using the name of Free Tree Society and/or its logos in any activity not previously approved by the Executive Committee.
